CERTIFIED MEDICATION AIDE COURSE-FALL 2026

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

CMAs are trained to work under supervision of a nurse to provide routine medications in a long term care setting. Upon completion of the course, students will be eligible to take the state CMA examination. All courses are approved by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS).

- ***Excel in CTE Eligibility Requirements (set by the state)**
 - Be a junior or senior.
 - Have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
 - Have completed at least one-half of the credit hours required for graduation according to their school district's graduation policy.
 - High school transcript AND CTE Compliance Form is needed before a seat will be held in the course.
- The following documentation is needed after enrolling in the course:
 - Kansas CNA certification
 - **Reading scores submitted: You may submit your ACT scores or if you have not taken the ACT, you can register to take the Accuplacer reading test at Fort Hays Tech | North Central. Contact Fort Hays Tech | North Central to schedule. Your seat in the course will not be reserved until we receive a score.**
 - 18 years of age by the course end date
 - TB Skin test (test must be within the last year)
 - Documentation of the following vaccinations, or notify instructor of need for vaccination exemption from the clinical facility:
 - Flu shot (for clinicals held during fall/winter months)
- This is a hands-on course/career. Students MUST be physically able to perform all skills satisfactorily, which includes ability to lift 50+ pounds.
- Criminal convictions may jeopardize eligibility for certification and/or employment. If you are unsure or have questions about this, please contact the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services/Health Occupations Credentialing (KDADS/HOC): kimberly.garrett@ks.gov or 785.296.6958.
- Attendance is required in ALL class and clinical sessions. Check the clinical location and schedule before registering in the class to make sure it fits your schedule. If you have other commitments (sports, clubs, a job, etc) that will interfere with this schedule, you are advised to take this course at a more convenient time.
- Uniform: Scrubs (any color/pattern) and a watch with a second hand for clinicals.
- Textbook: Kansas CMA Curriculum Guidelines. This book is provided to the student in pdf format and is included in the course tuition/.fees; Nursing Drug Handbook: recommended but not required.
- Class size is limited to 6 students
 - Students will only have a seat in the class after they make full payment
 - Students can NOT drop or withdraw the course after it begins.
 - No refunds are issued once payment is made.
